

ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SRO SERVICES

The Guilford County Board of Education ("Board" or "GCS") and the City of High Point ("City") have entered into a Contract for SRO Services for the 2020-21 school year. In addition to the terms and conditions of the Contract, the relationship is governed by the MOU the parties agreed to in the MOU dated June 15, 2018. In light of the Health Emergency resulting from COVID-19 and its related effects on restrictions which resulted in school closures, remote instruction, limitations in building and bus capacities, required social distancing and increased cleaning and other protocols affecting the operation of schools, the parties to the Contract for SRO Services agree to modify key terms to the Contract as follows:

1. No monies will be paid for any work done from the period from July 1, 2020 through February 28, 2021. Because students were not physically on the campuses historically served by the City, the SROs for those schools were not in service for GCS during that period of time.
2. From March 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, GCS shall pay for the services of eight (8) officers unless those officers do not perform duties as a result of school closures as a result of a pandemic or other health emergency.
3. In the event that an officer is absent pursuant to the reason listed in Section 2 above, the City will calculate the per diem credit owed to GCS and deduct that amount in the invoice submitted for the final yearly payment it submits to GCS on or before June 10, 2021.
4. GCS shall pay \$193,541.82 to City minus any per diem credit pursuant to Section 3 above based on an invoice to be submitted consistent with this Agreement on or about June 10, 2021.
